

What is Purple Mash?

Purple Mash is a cross-curricular resource covering Art to Science and all subjects in between. Your child can access Purple Mash from home on a laptop, desktop, mobile device, or a tablet. It is a safe environment that does not require any downloading or allow interaction with people online and children cannot make any financial transactions.

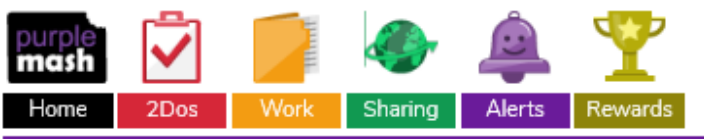
How to login to Purple Mash

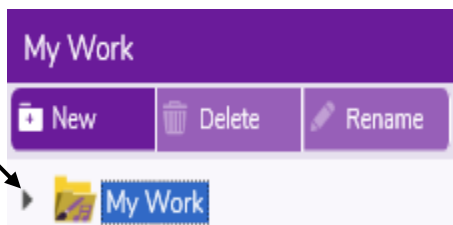
This will take you to the Queen's Park Academy Login page. Use your username and password that the class teacher has given you to login to Purple Mash.

How to find the daily task sheet and other worksheets for the day.

The teacher will create a weekly sheet which has daily lessons for English, Maths, Reading and Topic. Sometimes the tasks will be Purple Mash tasks which will then be set as a 2Do, sometimes you might need to open a worksheet that you can then do either on the computer as a word document or on paper and sometimes the task might be something practical or a game.



To find the daily task sheet. Click on the orange work folder



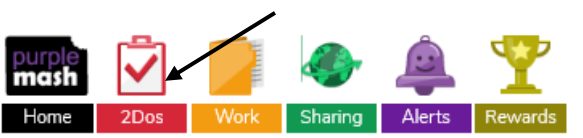
This will open the area where all the folders are.

Click on the small triangle next to the 'my work folder'. This will open to reveal your child's folder.

This will reveal a weekly folder which contains the daily task sheets and any other worksheets that you will need for each day. Just click on the folder with the week that you want.

How to find my 2Dos.

If your teacher has set any work that uses one of the Purple Mash tools, these are called 2Dos and they will be explained on your daily task sheet.



You can find all the 2Do activities that have been set for you by clicking on the 2Do icon. Just click start to begin your 2Do, or if you are returning to a 2Do click open work.

How to save my work.

2Do activities- work that has been set by your teacher

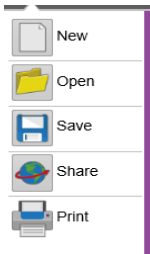
2Dos that have been set for you will save automatically into the correct place for your teacher to find. When you have completed a 2Do which is a game or a quiz, it will automatically save in the correct place. If you have been set a 2Do which uses one of the Purple Mash Tools, this will save automatically into the correct place when you either:



At the top of the page. Click the red icon with white arrow to exit. It gives you the option to save and exit. Click save and exit and it will save automatically into the correct place.

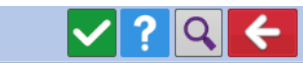


At the top of the page. Click the purple icon with three white lines. This will open some options.

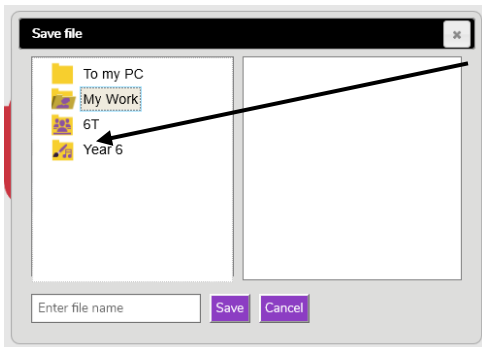


These are the options that appear when you click on the purple icon. Click on the save icon and your 2Do will save automatically into the correct place.

Extra Activities: You may choose to explore the many tools and games that there are on Purple Mash that have not been set by your teacher. If you want to save any extra activities that you complete, please save them in your 'my work' folder. There are two ways to do this.

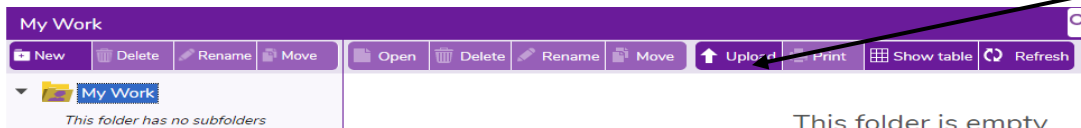


Exit your work by clicking on the red icon or on the purple icon with three white lines. Click on save.



The save file box will then appear which will show you all the folders that you have as options as places to save your work. The 'My Work' folder is already selected for you. Give your file a name (your first name and a title for your work) and click save. Your work will now be saved into your personal 'My Work' folder. The work in this folder can only be seen by you and your teacher.

How to upload files to your 'My Work' folder



This folder is empty

Open your 'My work'

folder and click the upload button on the purple tool bar. This will open a box that will allow you to browse the files on your computer or other device. You can upload Word, PDF and pictures to your 'My Work' folder. This means that your teacher will be able to see the work that you have been completing at home.
