



Dear Parents/Carers,

We are delighted to announce that we will be holding an outdoor Graduation Ceremony on Thursday 22nd July from 1pm for Year 6 pupils. A maximum of two adults per child will be admitted to this event and other than your Year 6 child, children are not able to attend. Please can you complete this form to show who will be attending for your child and their contact details – this is required for track and trace purposes and for catering purposes. Due to the changes in government guidance, face masks are optional. If there are any changes to restrictions, we will notify you.

Adults will be able to arrive from 12:45pm onto the playground via the side gate and will need to be seated before 1pm, ready for the ceremony to start. After the ceremony, at approximately 2pm, adults and the Year 6 children will be invited to an outside afternoon tea consisting of juice, cakes and scones with jam and cream. Please feel free to bring a picnic blanket or you are more than welcome to use the chairs provided.

We have arranged for a photographer to attend and take individual portrait photographs of the children. These need to be pre-booked on ParentPay and are £5 for a 8 x 6 mounted photograph. We will send these home with the children on the 23rd July. The photographer or school will not be able to accept any payment on the day and the booking system will close on 21st July.

Finally, as part of our end of year celebration, year 6 pupils will be making their own pizzas. These will form their lunch on Friday 23rd July 2021 along with fruit, a biscuit bar, crisps, a yoghurt and a cup of squash. These items will be provided by the school. If your child does not want to have this, they are more than welcome to bring their own packed lunch that day. Please ensure your child brings a snack for break time as usual and their water bottle.
