These will need to be ones that you do not mind getting dirty at Moors Valley. • Appropriate clothing for the weather e.g. jeans/shorts, t-shirt, hoodie. • Children will need to bring in a snack and lunch for both trips. If you are eligible for school meals, this will be provided for you. • Two bottles of water are required. (Paulton's Park and Moors Valley do not require these for children under 12 years of age). • Personal hand gel (hand gel will be provided by staff). 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No money will be needed on these trips. We will not be entering the gift shops due to COVID-19 restrictions. • Mobile phones (these can still be brought into school and left there for the day). • Cameras.
