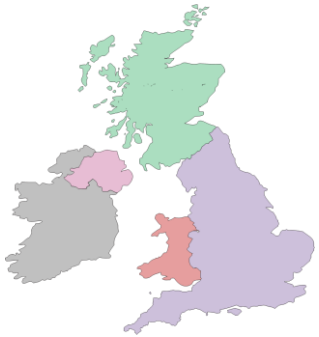
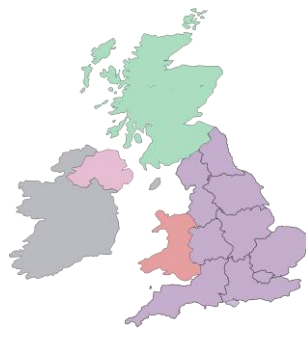


The United Kingdom
