Kusama is a contemporary artist from Japan. She is famous for her use of polka-dot patterns. She has often created pumpkin sculptures, describing the shape of a pumpkin as 'humorous'.



Kusama is also famous for her use of reflected lights in mirrors. She has created mirrored 'infinity rooms', in which she has suspended thousands of LED lights which reflect in the mirrors and create a feeling of infinite (unending) space.
